#### What is the 340B Discount Drug Program?

Umpqua Community Health Center (UCHC) participates in a government program that helps patients save money on their medications and provides resources to strengthen health care in our community.

Participating in this program is easy!

If you are a cash patient, pick up a 340B card at our front desk, and take it along with your prescription to one of our pharmacy partners. At the pharmacy, you may **save up to 60% off** the cost of your family's medications.

#### What if I have insurance coverage?

We encourage our patients with insurance coverage to take their prescriptions to a participating pharmacy.

If your medications are covered by your policy, you will pay your copay as usual. Although your costs will not change, our health center will receive a financial benefit from your insurance company. This additional funding helps us provide care to the neediest families in our community. If your medications are not covered by your insurance, this program may reduce the cost of your prescription by up to 60%.

## Can I share my card with other people?

Your drug card is for your use only.

However, all patients who see
their primary doctor at our health
center are eligible to participate
in the program and may obtain
their own card.

### What if my doctor refers me to a specialist?

Prescriptions written by specialists may also be covered under this program.

# Are all medications covered? Most medications are included in this program.

## How does UCHC use their 340B savings?

- Mercy Outreach support for dental in schools
- Financial slides
- Bad debt dissolution
- Free support clinics for the community such as smoking cessation and diabetes education

#### Who is eligible?

There are three criteria for eligibility:

- Establish care with a provider at Umpqua Community Health Center
- Receive a prescription from that provider
- Fill a prescription at a pharmacy who contracts with UCHC
